NOTICE OF COMMENT & PUBLIC HEARING
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE CONSOLIDATED 2008 ACTION
PLAN

The City of Chesapeake is conducting a public meeting to gather comments and input on the draft substantial amendment to the City's Consolidated Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2008 (Program Year 34-7/1/08-6/30/09). The public meeting will be held:

The City will amend FY 2008 Action Plan by adding the supplemental Community Development Block Grant Recovery (CDBG-R) program funding. It is anticipated that the City of Chesapeake will receive \$331,823 in (CDBG-R) funds from the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The City has proposed utilizing CDBG-R funds for the following purpose:

1. VA Supportive Housing-Single Room Occupancy (SRO) South Bay Apartments. Construct sixty (60) studio apartments for chronically homeless single adults (\$300,000).
2. Our House Family Shelter-rehabilitation of emergency shelter (\$31,823).
