REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Dog owner purchasing membership must be at least 18 years old.
- Male dogs over 1 year must be neutered.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months old.
- Dog owner must provide proof of animal registration with license number from city/county of residence.
- Dog owner must provide up-to-date documentation of vaccinations including:
 - Rabies (with tag number)
 - D(H)APP / DA2PP (Distemper/Parvo)
 - Bordetella.
- Dog owner must comply with all City of Chesapeake dog park ordinances and related Virginia State Code.

CITY OF CHESAPEAKE DOG PARK ORDINANCE

Section 50-22 Domestic animals; dog parks.

(a) No person shall bring or be responsible for the entry of a dog or other domestic animal into areas other than automobile parking concourses and walks immediately adjacent thereto and in such other areas as may be clearly marked by signs. Except in an area specifically designated as a Dog Park, subject to paragraphs (b) and (c) of this section, nothing in this section shall be construed as permitting the running of dogs at large. All dogs in those areas, other than dog parks, where such animals are permitted shall be restrained at all times on adequate leashes not greater than five feet in length.

(b) A "dog park" is a fenced or otherwise enclosed area within a city park that is clearly marked by signs posted in the area, where dogs are allowed to be released from leashes.

(c) Any owner or other person bringing a dog or dogs to the dog park (the "responsible party") shall be legally responsible for any injury, property damage, or other loss caused by the dog or dogs in his or her care.

(d) The City, in creating dog parks, relies upon all immunities existing at common law and by statute, including, but not limited to Virginia Code 15.2-1809.

(e) Access to and continuing use of dog parks is conditioned upon the following:

- (1) All dogs must be licensed, vaccinated, and wear a collar with identification and current tags.
- (2) The responsible party must carry a leash at all times and remain with the dog in the dog park. Leashes should be removed immediately upon entrance to the dog park, and dogs must be leashed when removed from the dog park.
- (3) Dangerous dogs and vicious dogs as defined in section 10-47.1 are prohibited. Dogs must be removed at the first sign of dangerous behavior toward people or other dogs.
- (4) Dogs that are ill, less than four months of age, an unneutered male over the age of one, and females in heat are prohibited from entering a dog park.
- (5) The responsible party must clean up and dispose of waste left by their dogs and provide any necessary equipment for removal and disposal.
- (6) Children under eight years of age are not permitted in the dog park except during approved events or activities sanctioned by the City.
- (7) No responsible party shall be in possession of more than three dogs at a time within the dog park.
- (8) Responsible parties must prevent dogs from digging within the dog park and immediately refill any holes.
- (9) No food, drink, or tobacco products are allowed within the enclosed area of the dog park.

(f) Violation of any of these rules is cause for expulsion of the dog and the responsible party from the dog park. In addition, violation of any of the items set forth in paragraph (e) is a class 3 misdemeanor.

(g) The Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism may impose any additional rules and regulations it deems necessary to ensure safe and efficient use of the dog park.

ANNUAL FEES & PRICING

(January 1 - December 31)

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP: \$10 PER DOG

DAY PASS: \$5 [with Proof of Vaccinations]

REPLACEMENT TAG: \$3

For your convenience, our Administrative Office and Visitor Center also issues Chesapeake Animal Licenses for dogs AND cats! Just bring your rabies vaccination and tag number.

Animal License Fees:

Non-neutered/non-spayed pet: \$10

Neutered/spayed pet: \$4

(payable to "Chesapeake Treasurer")

Park Staff will monitor and spot-check proper dog park usage including verifying licenses and compliance with dog park rules and ordinances. Tickets for non-compliance will be issued.



DOG PARK RULES

ENFORCED BY CITY CODE 50-22



Open Sunrise - Closed at Sunset

- Use park at your own risk.
- Current Dog Park membership tag required to enter, **Code 46-135.**
- All dogs must be licensed, vaccinated and wear a collar with identification and current tags.
- Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the Park and their responsible party must carry a leash at all times while in the Park.
- Dogs must be accompanied by an adult and monitored within the Dog Park at all times.
- Dangerous dogs and vicious dogs as defined in **Section 10-4.1** are prohibited. Dogs must be removed at the first sign of uncontrollable or aggressive behavior toward people or other dogs.
- Owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) at all times.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up by the responsible party immediately.
- All personal belongings must be removed when exiting the park. Any personal belongings left in the park will be discarded.
- Only children ages 8 and older are able to enter the Dog Park and must be accompanied by an adult.
- No responsible party shall be in possession of more than 3 dogs at a time within the dog park.
- Responsible parties must prevent dogs from digging within the Dog Park and immediately refill any holes.

NOT PERMITTED

- Unattended dogs & children
- Human & Dog food/treats
- Tobacco or alcohol products
- Unneutered males over the age of 1 year
- Dogs in heat
- Pools and hoses
- Large dogs in the small dog park
- Sick dogs
- Aggressive dogs
- Puppies under 4 months old
