The City of Chesapeake has received and accepted for publication and conceptual phase consideration an unsolicited proposal under the provisions of the Public-Private Education Facilities And Infrastructure Act of 2002 (PPEA) and the City of Chesapeake's Guidelines for the Implementation of the Public-Private Education Facilities And Infrastructure Act of 2002 (Guidelines). The PPEA unsolicited proposal is for design and construction of a sanitary sewer project to serve the residents of Philmont Avenue in the Norfolk Highlands section of the City of Chesapeake.

The City of Chesapeake intends to evaluate the unsolicited proposal and may negotiate an interim or comprehensive agreement with the proposer based on the proposal. Copies of the unsolicited proposal shall be available upon request, subject to the provisions of the Virginia Freedom of Information Act, Code of Virginia, PPEA and the City of Chesapeake's Policy and Guidelines.

The City of Chesapeake will receive for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals that comply with the PPEA and the PPEA guidelines adopted by the City of Chesapeake. Competing proposals for this project must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, December 10, 2020 at the City of Chesapeake Purchasing Division 306 Cedar Road, 5th Floor Chesapeake, Virginia 23322 to the attention of the City Manager's designee, Mr. Anthony E. Cannon, Procurement Administrator. This is an actual, and not a postmark deadline. No additional proposals prepared in response to this PPEA public notice shall be accepted after this date and time. Any private entity submitting a competing proposal shall provide the City of Chesapeake Division of Purchasing one (1) original proposal and twenty (20) copies, and a certified check in the amount of \$5,000.00, payable to the City of Chesapeake.

Summary unsolicited conceptual proposal:

The proposal is for the design and construction of a Philmont Avenue Sanitary Sewer Project to provide 1,040 linear feet of 8" gravity sewer, a package grinder pump station and 218 linear feet of small diameter force main discharging to a gravity manhole within the sewershed of the City of Chesapeake Pump Station Number 127.
