

# Centerville Water Main - Loop 3

## Water Main Project Newsletter

The City of Chesapeake Department of Public Utilities has begun construction of the Centerville Water Main – Loop 3 project. The Project was awarded to Tidewater Utilities Construction Incorporated. This project installs a water main along Centerville Turnpike, completing a loop from Mount Pleasant Road to Elbow Road. When complete, the water main will improve reliability and fire protection for neighborhoods east of Clearfield Avenue and Butts Station Road.

This will be the first of several newsletters we will send you throughout the project to keep you updated on the work and what will be happening in the coming months. We hope the following information will help answer your most frequently asked questions.

#### **What can residents and businesses expect during construction?**

Construction started on October 24, 2022, and is anticipated to take 16 months to complete. In general, the working hours are from 7 am to 4 pm, Monday through Friday. You will continue to have access to your property throughout the construction project although there may be brief blockages while work takes place directly in front of your property. In addition, regular trash pickup, mail delivery, and emergency services will be maintained.

Because much of the work is in the street, you can expect traffic delays and detours during construction.

#### **How will this project affect traffic on Centerville Turnpike?**

Unfortunately, construction of this magnitude can be disruptive to traffic. This is particularly true in this case, as the water line is being constructed along a heavily traveled corridor that is already impacted by bridge lifts that occur every 30 minutes. During much of the construction project, traffic will be further restricted to one travel lane. In addition, Centerville Turnpike will be closed to thru traffic for approximately 8 consecutive weekends and traffic will be detoured starting in late January/early February.

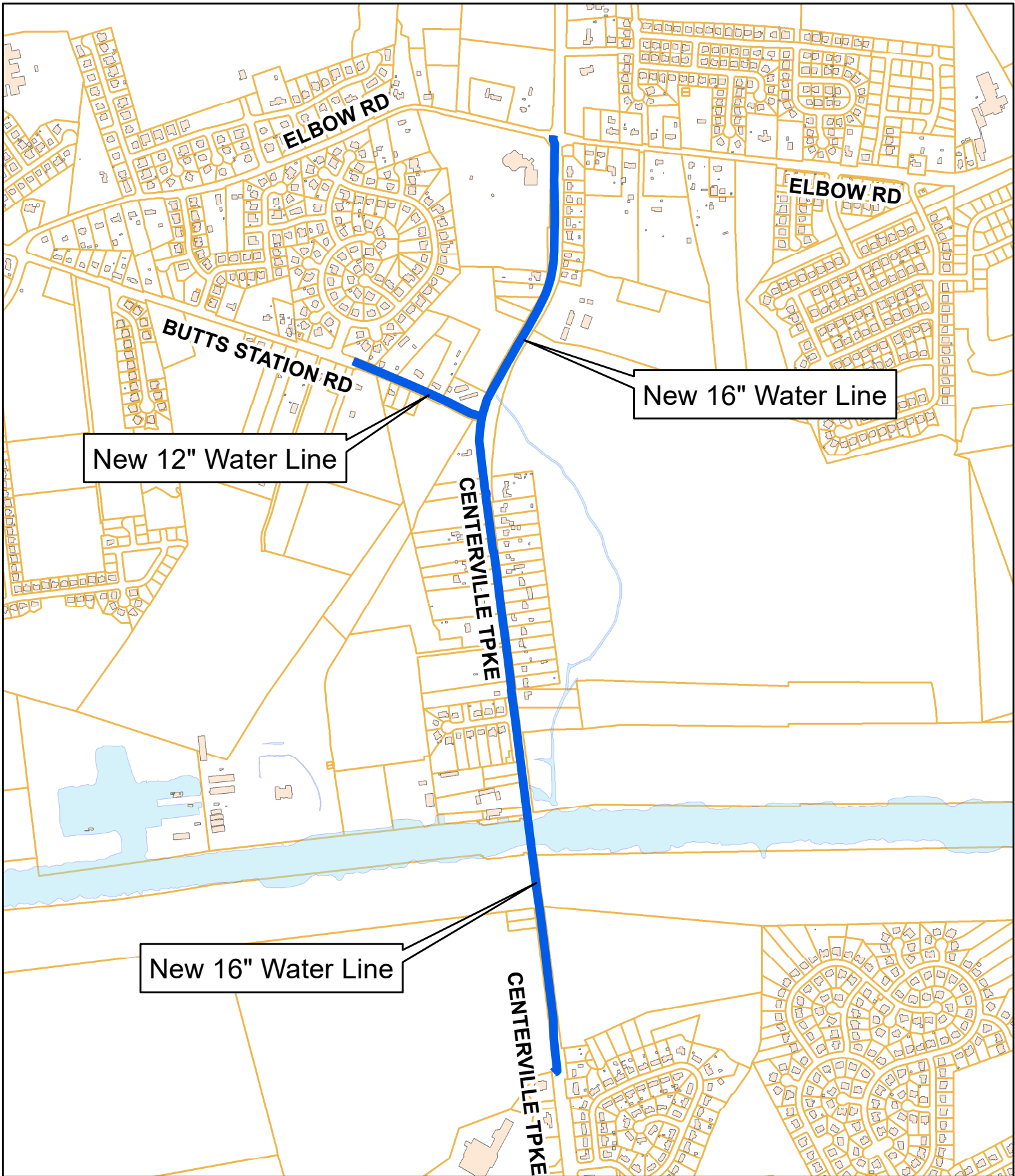
