

Dominion Boulevard I-64 Force Main Replacement Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project Newsletter

Newsletter No. 1 September 2022

The City of Chesapeake Department of Public Utilities will soon begin construction of the Dominion Boulevard I-64 Sanitary Sewer Force Main Replacement project. This project was awarded to Peters & White Construction Company. This will be the first of several newsletters we will send you throughout construction to keep you updated on the work and what will be happening in the coming months. We hope the following information will help answer your most frequently asked questions.

What type of work will be completed with this project?

The project was developed after a sanitary sewer force main broke under the I-64, Dominion Boulevard, and Chesapeake Expressway interchange. This project involves the installation of a new sewer force main in a new location outside the busy highway. The project area (see map on back) includes Independence Parkway, Volvo Parkway, and Byron Street.

What can residents and businesses expect during construction?

Construction is anticipated to start in October 2022. In general, working hours will be from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Construction is anticipated to take approximately one year with the completion of the project occurring in October 2023.

Because much of the work is in the streets, you can expect some traffic delays and detours during construction.

Unfortunately, construction of this magnitude can be disruptive. However, the city and its contractor will work very hard to minimize disruptions. Regular trash pickup, mail delivery, and emergency services will be maintained. There may be brief periods when sewer service is turned off to switch your service to the new system. **You will be notified in advance when service is interrupted.**

You will continue to have access to your property throughout construction although there may be brief blockages while work takes place directly in front of your property.

We ask for your patience during this project. The city will have full-time inspectors on-site throughout the construction period to ensure the work is done efficiently and disruptions are kept to a minimum. Should you have any questions during construction or experience a specific problem with the work, please let one of our inspectors know.

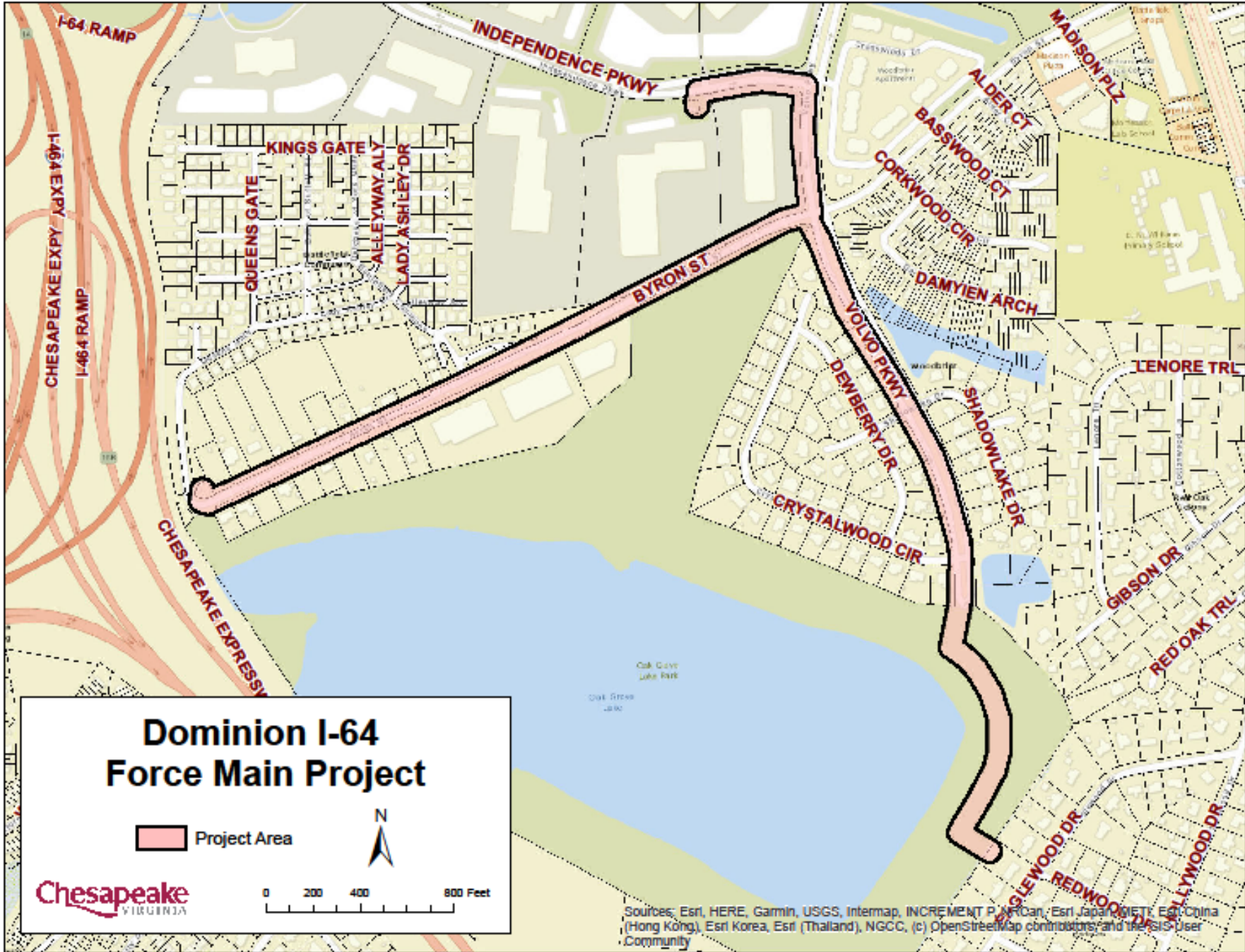
As the project progresses, continued updates will be provided. Again, we thank you for your patience and understanding.
